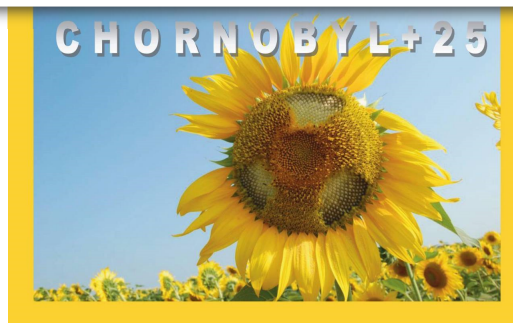
### Topic: Cycling in Ukrainian Village
